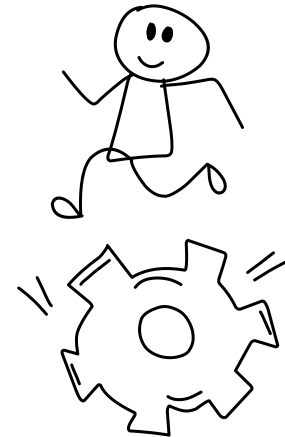
Developmental tutoring

Different roles of a tutor

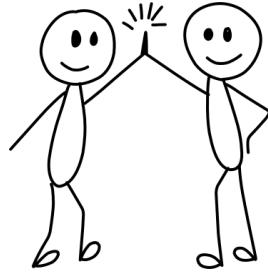
Mentor: sharing knowledge and experience.

Coach: helping the student reflect, set goals, and solve problems.

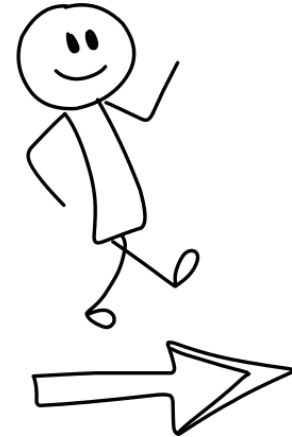


Challenges and effects

Tutoring is not easy to use at universities. This is because the work is often done one-on-one or in very small groups.



It also takes a lot of time and needs strong effort from both the tutor and the student.



Both sides need to work hard during the process. Tutors need to prepare, adapt, and support students, while students must take part actively and take responsibility for their learning.

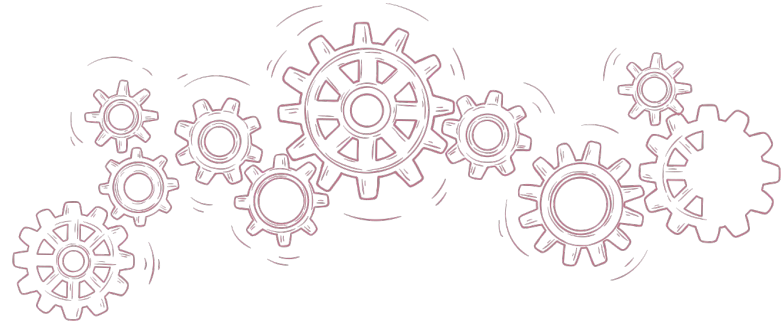
Personalized education is a process, and its effects are reflected in professional and personal successes.
